The double shotgun tournament will be held at Ironwood Golf & Country Club with tee times at 8:00 am and 1:00 pm. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams at an awards ceremony following the tournament.

A Tournament Kick Off Dinner and Auction will be held on Thursday, June 5, 2014 at 6:30 pm at The Hilton Greenville. Tickets are \$35 per person and include a plated dinner, beer, wine and entertainment. There will be an exciting selection of live and silent auction items on which to bid. The dinner and auction is open to the public, but tickets must be purchased in advance.

JWA President Stephanie Bunn says "Positively impacting our community is at the heart of what JWA strives to do. We hope that businesses and individuals in Pitt County will join our effort to raise funds for the Ronald McDonald House of Eastern North Carolina by participating in the 5th Annual Mac Attack Golf Tournament and Silent Auction. JWA is extremely grateful for the community support that Mac Attack has received in the past and we are looking forward to making this year's Mac Attack another successful fundraiser to benefit a deserving organization that makes a difference in the lives of families in Eastern North Carolina, The Ronald McDonald House."

Two hundred dinner guests and thirty-four golf teams participated in the Fourth Annual Mac Attack Golf Tournament in 2013, which raised \$33,500 for the Ronald McDonald House of Eastern North Carolina. The Ronald McDonald House provides a temporary home away from home for families who have seriously ill or injured children in the hospital or being treated in local medical facilities. A \$10 donation is asked for a night's stay, but no one is ever denied a place to stay for their inability to pay.
